



## The Education Fund's Ocean Bank Center for Educational Materials' 2010 Art Exhibition.

### EXHIBITION PACKET

\$5,500 in prizes and the opportunity for your student and teacher artwork to appear in a full-color booklet featuring the winning artwork.

#### **Rules:**

1. Artwork for the Art Exhibition ***must*** incorporate at least some material from The Education Fund's Ocean Bank Center for Educational Materials (OBCEM).
2. Any MDCPS art teacher or student may submit artwork. Student artwork must be submitted through the art teacher.
3. Judging is based on the quality of the work and the creativity in using materials from the Ocean Bank Center. In the case of student art, consideration will be given for the grade level.
4. **Deadline for all art to be turned in: February 19, 2010.**
5. Size limits: Flat pieces (2-D) up to 3' x 5' and 3-D pieces up to 6' x 4' x 4'. Weight limit: 50-lb max.
6. Artwork can be entered as an individual piece or group piece – all MDCPS levels can enter (elementary, middle, senior high).
7. Identification label (see packet) must be securely attached to the back of the art piece.
8. A completed description sheet (see packet) must be included for each art piece inside the portfolio (for 2-D) or the box (for 3-D).
9. Portfolios and boxes are to be addressed to "OBCEM Art Exhibition".
10. All pieces must be properly packaged to avoid damage. (The Education Fund is not responsible for damage to artwork).
11. Every piece must indicate (on the identification label and description sheet) whether or not it can be sold at the Silent Auction. When donating student pieces, it is recommended that you discuss the donation with the student and the parent (or responsible adult).

\*Prizes will be gift certificates to the art teacher(s) to be used for art materials for ongoing classroom lessons.

To reward student art focused on one of today's three critical environmental categories: water & sewer (themes of water resources + water purity), solid waste (themes of reusing/recycling everyday items), and South Florida's eco-system (themes of environmental preservation + support). This category is intended to encourage hands-on creativity in reusing materials to make art with an environmental theme, it also aims to have students and parents learn about the Ocean Bank Center for Educational Materials and the concept of reusing/recycling everyday items.

As a condition for student art to be considered for winning prizes in one of the three environmental categories (water & sewer, solid waste, and South Florida's eco-system), each art piece must be accompanied by a 1-page typed explanation of the research which inspired the submitted art. See page 3 of this packet for the environmental writing requirement.

To achieve science-based environmental art, art teachers are encouraged to work with their school's science teachers. Art teachers may share with the science teacher's classroom, any prize money won as a result of that collaboration.
